- iv) Conducting Spell- Bee Sessions to encourage students
- v) Conducting Mock Interview Training Sessions to the students

- vi) Coordinating group activities and providing student support: engaging with weak learners, encouraging and enhancing student confidence

**c. Enrichment of Campus life:**

- i. Encouraging students participating in various literary activities like Essay writing, Elocution, Debate, Quiz, Role play and Group Discussions
- ii. Encouraging students participating in various Cultural activities like singing, dancing and acting and so on.
